## State of Illinois Health Requirements & Student Documents Needed

### 2024 - 2025 School Year

The St. Patricia School "Organization Day" will be on August 15, 2024 from 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM. This is the day we request, among other things, that parents bring in copies of required health documents for students.

#### PHYSICALS / IMMUNIZATIONS

The Physical examination for schools shall be conducted within one year before the following:

- Entering School (this includes preschool and transfer students in any grade at the time of entry or transfer).
- Entering Kindergarten or first grade, (in addition to the preschool physical).
- Entering sixth grade. The meningococcal vaccine and TDap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) boosters are also due in sixth grade.

Please note: These examinations must include the child's up-to-date immunization status. Sports physicals are not acceptable. Parents, please complete the yes/no medical history questions on the back of the physical form and sign and date it. The date of the examination must be within one year (on or after 8/15/2023). The physical must be signed by the doctor, nurse practitioner or physician assistant. Check to be sure the doctor, CNP or PA checks the box above their signature that relates to permission to participate in gym or interscholastic sports (ISS).

**Sports physicals will be due before starting a new competitive season. If your child is planning to play sports next year, we must have a current sports physical on file prior to their participation in the sport.**

#### VISION

All children enrolling in kindergarten and any student enrolling for the first time in a school are required to have an eye examination.

#### DENTAL

All Illinois children in **Kindergarten, Grade 2, and Grade 6**, are required to have an oral health examination. Examinations must be performed by a licensed dentist, and he/she must sign the Proof of School Dental Examination form.
